Targeting Carbon Neutrality in 2050: Aiming for a 30% Reduction in CO₂ Emissions by 2030

NIPPON SHOKUBAI CO., LTD. (Headquarters: Osaka, Japan, President: Yujiro Goto, hereinafter "Nippon Shokubai"), has formulated a roadmap for reducing CO_2 ^{*1} emissions by 2050. This roadmap concerns our "Strategic Transformation for Environmental Initiatives," which is one of our "Three Transformations," and is based on "TechnoAmenity for the Future," the long-term vision of the Nippon Shokubai Group announced in April of this year. For our CO_2 emissions reduction target for 2030, which is the final year of our long-term vision, we set a reduction target of 10% last year, but based on movement towards reviewing Japan's greenhouse gas reduction target, we first revised the CO_2 emissions reduction target for Nippon Shokubai Group in Japan , which account for about 70% of the Group's total CO_2 emissions, to 30%. Going forward, we will also proceed to examine the reduction targets for our group companies outside Japan.

Additionally, in order to contribute to the reduction of CO_2 emissions throughout the entire supply chain (Scope 3 *2), the following items will also be strongly promoted.

- \cdot Development and expansion of Environmental Contribution Products (products that contribute to the reduction of CO₂ emissions when used, etc.)
- \cdot Development and dissemination of CO_2 recovery and recycling technology (carbon recycling technology)
- $\cdot Development$ and social implementation of material recycling and chemical recycling

- *1 CO₂: Our Group's emissions reduction targets are for greenhouse gases, but since they are mostly carbon dioxide (CO₂), they are referred to as CO₂ in this paper.
- *2 Scope 3: Indirect emissions (emissions by other companies related to business activities) other than Scope 1 (direct emissions of greenhouse gases by business entities) and Scope 2 (indirect emissions from the use of electricity, heat, and steam supplied by other companies).
